



# Tips for Teams

## About WECC

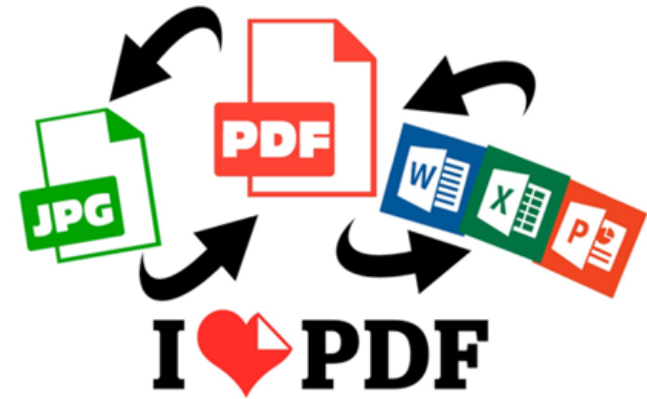
- Teams of students around the world prepare an analysis of an evaluation case
- Submissions are judged by evaluation experts
- A World Champion Team and regional winners are declared



- The case is in English
- Submissions may be in English, French or Spanish
- There is a time limit for preparing submissions
  - English language teams, 7 hours
  - French or Spanish submissions, 8 hours
  - Other language teams, 9 hours
  - Additional 15 minutes for downloading and uploading



- Submissions are anonymous
- Regular report or slideshow formats accepted
- Teams receive background information in advance
- The day before the event, the team contact person will be sent a key to the case file → **Do not open it right away!**



## Tips for before & during the event



- **Research efficiently**
- **Work as a team**



- **Decide logo, fonts, colours, etc. in advance**



- **Separate team tasks**
- **Manage time carefully**





- Remember the generic program evaluation issues



- Know evaluation process and methods



- Practice before the event using cases found online or in past WECC competitions



- **Structure the team's submission as requested**

The case doc will include guidance on structuring the submission. Topics usually include:

- Context of the program or project
- Theory of Change
- Monitoring and evaluation
- + Other topics



- **Before submitting**

Devote 15-20 minutes to reviewing the document.



# After the Competition

Teams will receive:

- Announcement of award winners
- Feedback from judges
- A post-competition survey, including an invitation to help organize the following year's competition
